



HOW DO I HOT SPOT?

What is hot spotting?

You may also hear this referred to as "tethering". Hot spotting is a way of sharing your phones cellular signal and data to access the internet between devices.

As long as you have your phone with you and usable data, you will always have a mini wifi router (your phone) where you can access the internet through different devices, allowing others to share your data service.

How does it work?

- Open settings on your phone
- Select "personal hotspot"
- Select "allow others to join"
- On your other device (the one without access to the internet) find the wifi icon. Usually in the top right or bottom right corner on a computer or tablet, or under "settings" if on a phone



- Find the device which has data in the list of options to connect to and select "join"
- It will ask you for a password. This is located back on the device with the data under "wifi password"
- Enter the password into the device without the data and now you have internet connection on both devices.
