

What is WiFi?

WiFi stands for 'Wireless Fidelity'. Wireless - without cables or wires. Fidelity - lasting support.



Basically, it is wireless technology used to connect your devices to the internet.

It gives you high speed access to the internet via a router or cell (usually called a 'dongle').

Your devices (i.e. your phone and laptop) are setup to automatically search for WiFi networks. To connect to the WiFi network, go to your settings and select WiFi or Networks (this will depend on what kind of technology you are trying to connect). All the networks that are available will be displayed on this page. Select the one you want, enter the WiFi password (if required) and you are off and running.
