RESTRICT ADMINISTRATIVE PRIVILEGES

What does it mean?

Restrict administrative privileges means limiting who can do certain powerful tasks on a system, like installing software or changing settings. Anything you have to log into will have a range of privileges or rights for people to use things like your square POS, your website, and your inventory management system.

Why would you do this?

If everyone can access these functions, it's easier for malware or hackers to take over your system. Hacking doesn't always come from an external source, your passwords or systems can be used unlawfully by internal people if put into the wrong hands.

An example

Only the IT team has admin rights, ensuring regular users can't install programs.
